NAAA The 2nd ANNUAL NACAC Road Race Series Trinidad and Tobago Leg Saturday 23 Oct 2011

The North America, Central America and Caribbean Athletic Association of the International Amateur Athletic Federation NACAC/IAAF is hosting a series of road races which commenced recently on September 25, 2011 in St Croix, US Virgin Islands and the 2nd leg in the British Virgin Islands on October 8th.

The series, which is open to all athletes age 18 years and over from all NACAC-member Federations and Guadeloupe, Martinique, Netherlands Antilles, Guyana and Suriname.

On October 23rd 2011, the National Association of Athletics Administrations Trinidad and Tobago will be the host country for the 3rd leg of the 10k series. The 10k event will begin at 7.00am. The race starts at Whitehall making one lap around the Queens Park Savannah then onto Maraval Road, over Long Circular Road, east along Western Main Road then onto Tragarete Road turning left at the Cipriani Boulevard finishing in front Queens Royal Collage.

Athletes are expected from around the Caribbean. USVI, Grenada, Guyana, St Vincent, Martnique, St Lucia, Tortolla and of course T&T top runners.

Registration forms have been sent to all clubs and will also take place on race day 5.30am to 6.30am.

Prizes will be awarded in US Dollars.
