Tyriq Horsford attends Javelin Training Camp at Loughborough University England

Loughborough University England extended an invitation for the three time CARIFTA Gold Medalist and record holder in the boys under 18 Javelin throw, Tyriq Horsford to attend their annual Sport Development: Javelin Training Camp which is carded for May 28 to 29, 2017.

This event will be used for tracking his personal progress as he prepares for the Commonwealth Youth Championships scheduled for July 19 -23, 2017 in the Bahamas. Coach Parker of Loughborough has indicated keen interest in working with Tyriq and his accompanying Coach Wade Franklyn.

The Camp is supported by British Athletics with a series of workshops and a competition component. 2017 will be the 6th Edition of the event which also caters for disabled athletes. Javelins will be presented to the winners of the competitions and Tyriq Horsford is a favorite for his age group.

The National Association of Athletic Administrations partnered with the Lalonde Gordon Sport Development fund and the National Gas Company of Trinidad and Tobago to enable this enriching opportunity for both Tyriq and Coach Wade who departed Trinidad on Thursday 25th May, 2017.

Horsford has won his Carifta titles with throws of 70.30m in St Kitts at age 15, 73.00m in Grenada, and 76.50 in Curacao. All indications are that Tyriq Horsford is set for big things in the javelin.
